Configuring Display Preferences

Identity Console has a new feature to customize the display settings. You can change the separator and the orientation of Distinguished Names (DNs) for a comprehensive view of the complete object DN. For more information, see [Configuring Display Preference for the Distinguished Name](#).

Improved Data Flow Table View

Enhanced data flow view to display Publisher and Subscriber channel for all the drivers.

Improved Driver Set Statistics

There is an enhancement in the driver set statistics. Along with each driver set statistics, the users can view Identity Manager's service usage metrics and driver distributions such as number of managed identities and managed driver instances for all the available driver sets. Identity Console 1.8 includes following software fixes:

Component	Issue ID	Description
Install and Upgrade	573863	NICI provides a notification on Windows builds, alerting users about the error.
Rights Management	571729	Implemented a UI table alignment fix on the Modify Trustee page. A search field is added to find the specific user from the list.
Identity Console	573751	Added a Disable SSLv3 check box in LDAP group configuration.
	572834	Contextless login configuration is not working if users pass all the parameters in single line. Users will be able to add all the required parameters and perform contextless login script.
	572576	Identity Console removes the members if the user does not have equivalentToMe value. The fix allows to preserve all the members.

Component	Issue ID	Description
	572836	Users were unable to assign password policy to Object Login Policy. Users can select Login policy object as a scope.
	571750	Under IDM Administrator > Jobs, users can view all the sorted list of object DNs in Scope.
	573392	Schema definitions with similar names but different attributes, leads to inconsistency. A fix is provided to load the schema correctly without any inconsistency.
	573541	Identity Console cannot edit Identity Manager Mapping tables - iManager and Designer can do this. Identity Console can now handle special characters and the data gets displayed correctly.
	603407	Two different attributes, member and uniqueMember have similar schema definitions that leads to inconsistency in Identity Console. uniqueMember is older and not used in latest eDirectory so would be considering only the member attribute in updating members in group. RAC Member can now add or remove members in group Management.
Identity Console Dashboard	572465	User could not view the complete object DN as it got truncated. Updated notation preference. User can change the display based on his preference either from left-right or right-left.
