1 What's New?

This release includes the following fixes:

- ◆ Bug 1096701 - Password policy is correctly selected in the Identity Vault browser.
- ◆ Bug 1100414 - The Refresh Connection option in the Identity Vault Properties page refreshes connections to all the configured servers.
- ◆ Bug 1103902 - Comparing driversets no longer report OutOfBoundsException exception.

2 Applying This Hotfix

You must be on Designer 4.7 at a minimum to apply this hotfix.

2.1 Online Update (using the Auto Update feature)

The auto-update feature that notifies you of new features available at the Designer Download Site. This feature allows you to download Designer package and patch updates when the computer that has Designer installed and is connected to the Internet.

- 1 Launch Designer.
- 2 From Designer's main menu, click **Help > Check for Designer Updates**.

- 3 Click **Yes** to accept the Designer updates.
- 4 Restart Designer for the changes to take effect.

2.2 Offline Update (Using the download page to apply the hotfix)

This hotfix includes `IDM47_Designer_4711.zip` file for updating Designer. You also can perform an offline update of Designer when the computer that has Designer installed and is not connected to the Internet. To perform an offline update, first download this hotfix on a local or remote computer and then point Designer to the directory containing the downloaded files.

To update Designer in an offline mode, create an offline copy of the Designer update files and then configure Designer to read the patch updates from the files copied to the local directory.

To create an offline copy of the Designer update files:

- 1 Go to [NetIQ Downloads Page](#).
- 2 Under **Patches**, click **Search Patches**.
- 3 Specify `IDM47_Designer_4711.zip` in the search box and download the file.
- 4 Log in to the computer that has Designer installed and create a local directory.
- 5 Unzip the downloaded files into the local directory.

To configure Designer to read the patch updates from the local directory:

- 1 Launch Designer.
- 2 From Designer's main menu, click **Windows > Preferences**.
- 3 Click **NetIQ > Identity Manager** and select **Updates**.
- 4 For URL, specify `file:///media/path_to_files/updatesite1_0_0/`
For a Linux mounted ISO, use the following URL format:
`file:///media/designer4711offline/updatesite1_0_0/`
- 5 Click **Apply**, then click **OK**.
- 6 From Designer's main menu, click **Help > Check for Designer Updates**.
- 7 Select the required updates and click **Yes** to accept and update the Designer.
- 8 Restart Designer for the changes to take effect.

3 Updating Oracle Java 1.8 Update 181

This hotfix updates Designer to support Oracle Java Runtime Environment (JRE) 1.8 Update 181.

- 1 On the computer where you installed Designer, download and install the JRE 1.8 Update 181 files in a local directory.

NOTE: For Mac OS, NetIQ recommends you to use only the `tar.gz` file from the [Oracle download](#) site.

For more information on install instructions, see the [Oracle documentation](#).

- 2 Open the `Designer.ini` file located in the Designer installation directory and update the JRE path.
- 3 Restart Designer.
