To update Standalone Identity Console, perform the following steps:

1. Download the IdentityConsole_140_P1_Linux.tar.gz file from the [Software and License Download](#) portal.
2. Untar the IdentityConsole_140_P1_Linux.tar.gz file.
3. Navigate to the IdentityConsole_140_P1_Linux folder and run identityconsole_patch_install.
